WHO ARE THE DATA CONTROLLERS OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

AXA Assistance UK Limited, a company under the laws of the United Kingdom, having its registered office at The Quadrangle, 106-118 Station Road, Redhill Surrey RH1 1 PR, United Kingdom, acts as an independent or joint data controller of the personal data processed in scope of this policy (it means that it determines the purposes and means of the processing of your personal data).

AXA Assistance UK Limited is referred to in this policy as "**AXA Partners**" or "**Data Controller**" or "**we**" or "**us**".
